Our 2024 Rosé is made in the Provence style, with delicate aromatics of strawberries and subtle notes of rose petals. The Cab Franc and Merlot grapes were direct-pressed before fermentation, in order to minimize color and create a light, refreshing wine for a summer day in Colorado.

Wine Name: **Cabernet Franc**
Year: **2023**

Narrative Description

Our 2023 Cabernet Franc stays true to form, with fruit-forward aromatics and peppery notes layered in. The palate is medium bodied, with nice acidity and medium tannin, highlighting bright raspberries, red current, and some hints of green bell pepper. Less usage of new oak leads to a clean, bright finish that makes this a crisp, refreshing red wine to enjoy on a warm Colorado day.

Wine Name: Hawkridge Cab Sauv
Year: 2023

Narrative Description

Sourced entirely from our premier Hawk Ridge Vineyard, this Cabernet opens with balanced aromatics of violet, black current, and green pepper. The intense, concentrated palate jumps right from the start, with huge flavors of black cherry and vanilla to go along with stiff, mouth-drying tannin and solid acidity that builds a structure to balance with the intense, sweet fruit flavors. With usage of 35% new French oak, the finish is layered with velvety tannin, dark flavors of cocoa, and sweet vanilla.
